



Second Time Around

Eligibility

Individual Event

3 entries per school

Time Limits

Project is pre-made before competition

Procedure

1. Participants report to the event area at the time and place stated on the conference map and program.
2. The event coordinator explains information, instructions, and deadlines to all participants.
3. Each participant brings in their project.
4. Participants set up display.
5. Judges evaluate items
6. Students pick up item at the end of the event
7. Entries are reviewed by judges. Neither students nor advisors are present at this time.

Regulations

- A. To create wearable garments and accessories out of unwanted/unused materials.
- B. In **upcycling**, an item or material is reused in a creative and new way. This could be an old curtain you turn into a dress.
- C. **Recycled**, the action or process of converting waste into reusable material. Recycling is the process of collecting and processing materials that would otherwise be thrown away as trash and turning them into new products. For example, taking capri sun pouches and turning them into a tote.
- D. Item must be washable and reusable.
- E. All entries must be created from previously used materials (recycled). All creations must be of **store quality** and **marketable**. Key words are store quality and marketable. In other words, could you display and sell it at a store. If the student is creating a necklace then they also need to create a bracelet, ring and or earrings.
- F. Item is premade. All entries must have a Theme (name) written on an index card, an 8 x 10 picture of someone wearing their accessories/garment and some kind creative of display.
- G. Participants may not disturb any event in progress, enter a restricted evaluation area, interrupt a conference function, or participate in behavior unbecoming of a conference participant.
 1. At the event meeting, the event coordinator will explain any further restrictions of the event.
 2. Failure to follow these instructions will result in disqualification.
- H. Participant will set up at assigned place
- I. All event participants will work together to leave event area clean.



Evaluation

Item will be judged on construction, quality, originality, marketability, presentation.

If you were at a Fashion Market would someone buy and sell it at their boutique.

Materials Needed

Any and all material that has been previously used.

The only materials that can be store bought are the findings; such as zippers, clasps, crimps, covers, baits, rivets, guards etc.
